
Thanksgiving Then and Now



- I. Give each student a copy of the "Thanksgiving Then and Now" matchbook reproducible.
- 2. Have students cut along the dotted line and fold along the solid lines to assemble the matchbook.
- 3. Prompt students to use crayons or markers to draw a picture of Thanksgiving long ago on the left side. Then invite them to draw a picture of Thanksgiving as they celebrate it today on the right side.
- 4. Have students lift the flap beneath the illustrations and write a sentence that describes each scene. You can have younger students copy a sentence frame and fill in the blanks. (For example, "At the first Thanksgiving, ______." And "Today, we celebrate by _____.")
- 5. Invite students to share their sentences as they reflect on the different ways we celebrate Thanksgiving.
