




A Summer Sight-Word Reader

Since making this book requires the use of a stapler, we recommend adult supervision.


- After printing them out, stack the full-page sheets in the following order:
 1. page 8/cover facedown
 2. page 2/page 7 faceup
 3. page 6/page 3 facedown
 4. page 4/page 5 faceup
- Carefully fold the entire stack in half and make a crease.
- Keeping the pages together, unfold the stack and staple three times along the length of the crease to make a spine. Be sure to staple through the top of the stack so that the tips of the staples are on the inside of the book.
- Now you're ready to color and read ***The Tree House***!
(To keep the color from bleeding through the pages, we suggest using crayons.)
