- 2 Choose a word to trace the top. Read the sentence on the mat and find the word on your mat. Use the word on your mat to write the word on the separate sheet of paper.

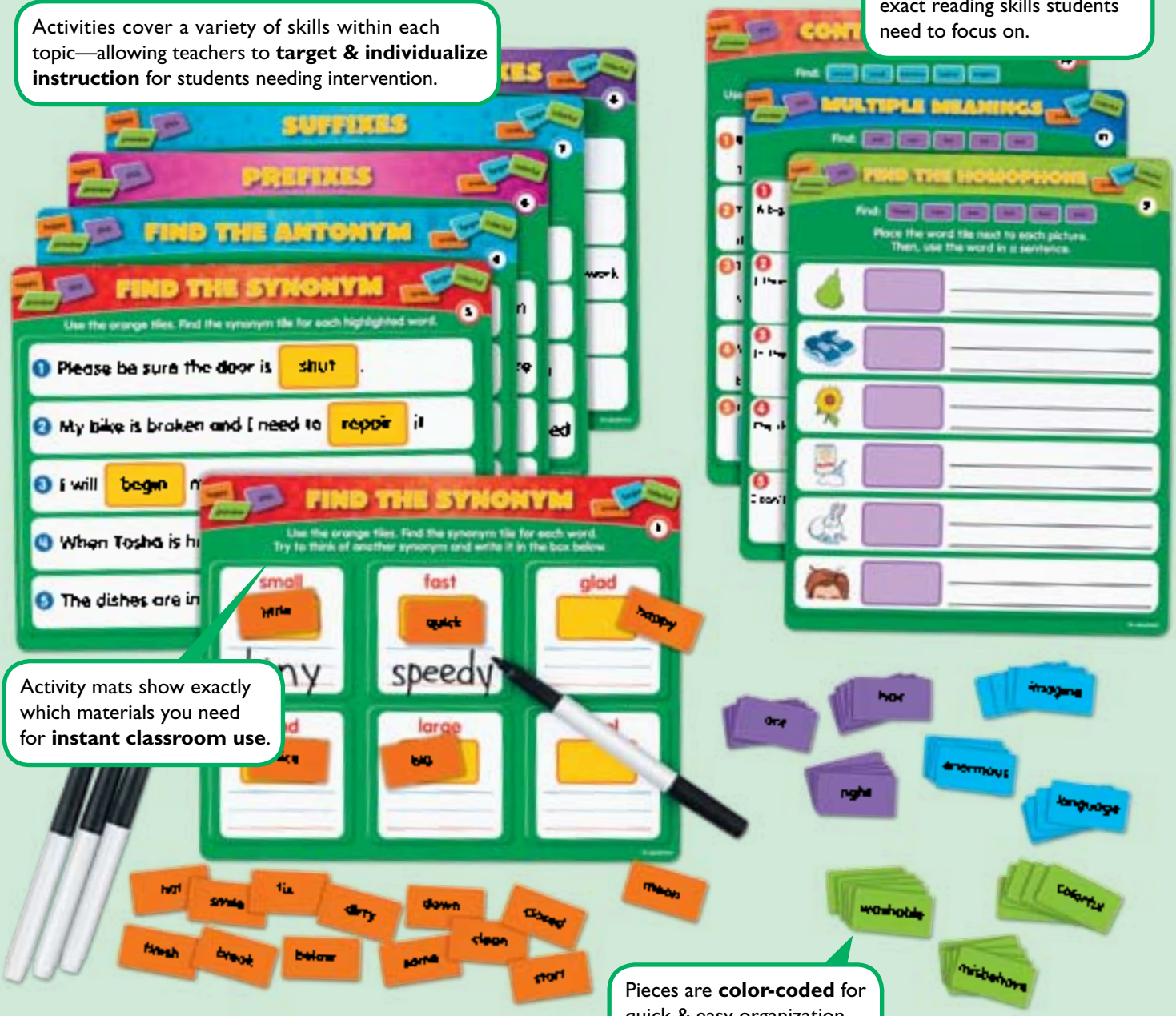
Implementation Idea

Implementation Idea

After using the books to model decoding skills with a group of 3 to 4 students, give each child a different book. Have the children decode words, then try using each word in their books in a sentence.

Key Features

Labeled dividers make it easy to find the book you need for targeted intervention lessons.

The teacher then provides targeted instruction addressing areas of need.

The teacher chooses 3 of these sounds and works with individual students to complete each column. The teacher then continues to assess students' progress by having them work with sounds they haven't practiced yet.

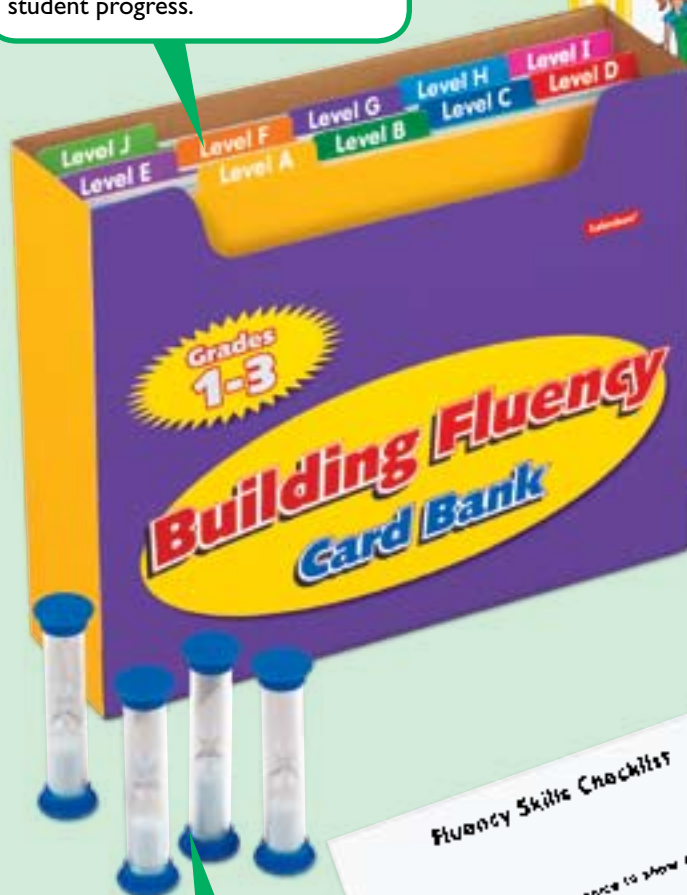

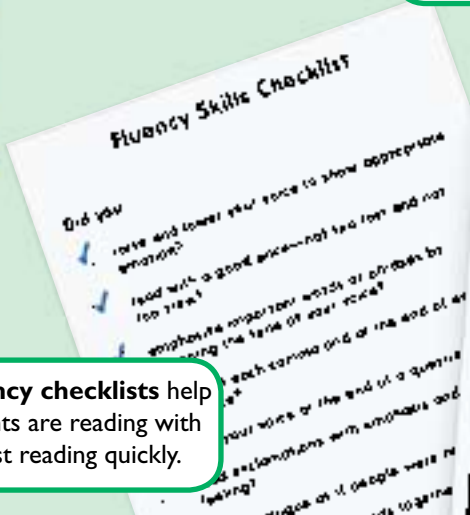

Response to Intervention (RTI) Application

Tier 1 The reading passages can be used as a whole-class activity to assess each student's fluency skills. Using the included timers, the teacher invites students to read aloud for one minute. The teacher records the number of words students have read correctly, then uses the students' scores to determine which students need more intensive instruction.

Tier 3 Teachers can use the passages with individual students to provide intensive, one-on-one instruction. The passages come in 10 different reading levels, so it's easy for teachers to provide passages matched to students' individual levels. The included fluency checklist helps show students that reading fluently involves more than just reading fast, but also includes reading with proper pacing, intonation & expression.

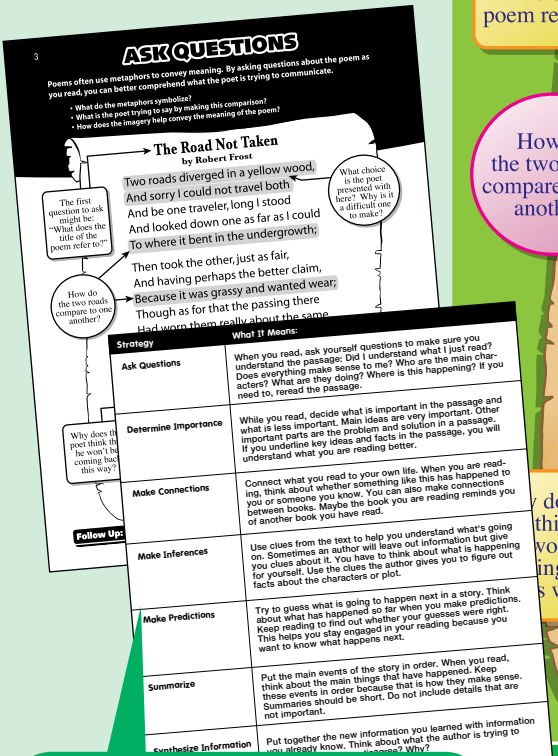

Had worn them really about the same,

The first question to ask might be: "What does the title of the poem refer to?"

What choice is the poet presented with here? Why is it a difficult one to make?

How do the two roads compare to one another?

How does the poet think that you won't be coming back this way?

In this poem, what do the two roads symbolize? What is the poet saying about the choices we make in life?

- Follow Up:
1. How does asking questions help you understand the poem?
 2. What questions did this poem bring to your mind? How did you answer all of your questions, or are some left unanswered?

Follow-up questions at the bottom of each chart help ensure student comprehension.

Response to Intervention (RTI) Application

Tier 2 The charts can be used with an intervention group of approximately 4 to 6 students. The teacher follows the teaching points built into the chart to introduce each strategy and read the passage—stopping at each text bubble to point out specific reading techniques. The teacher then uses the questions at the bottom of the chart as an informal assessment of students' comprehension.

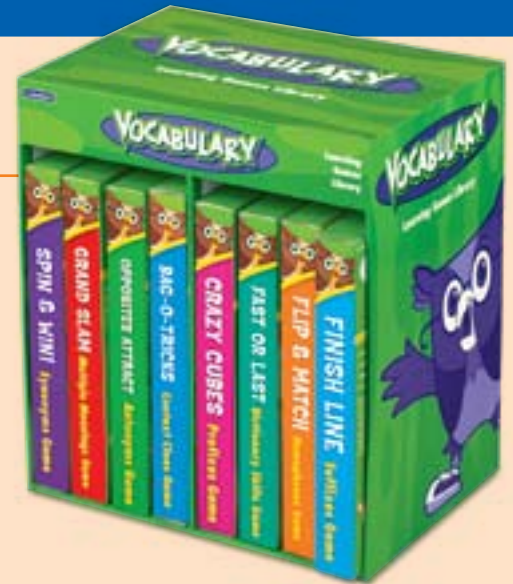

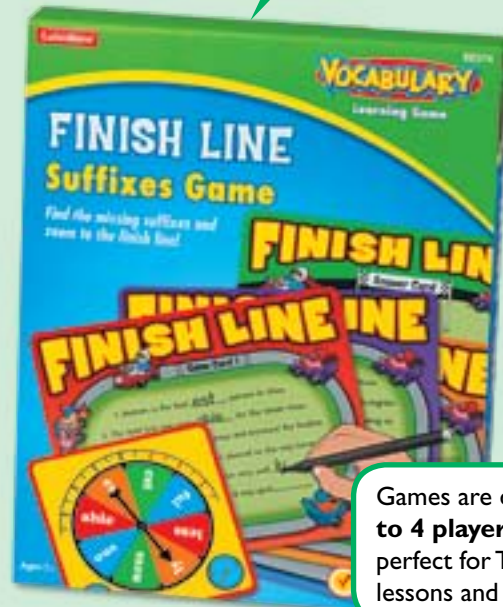

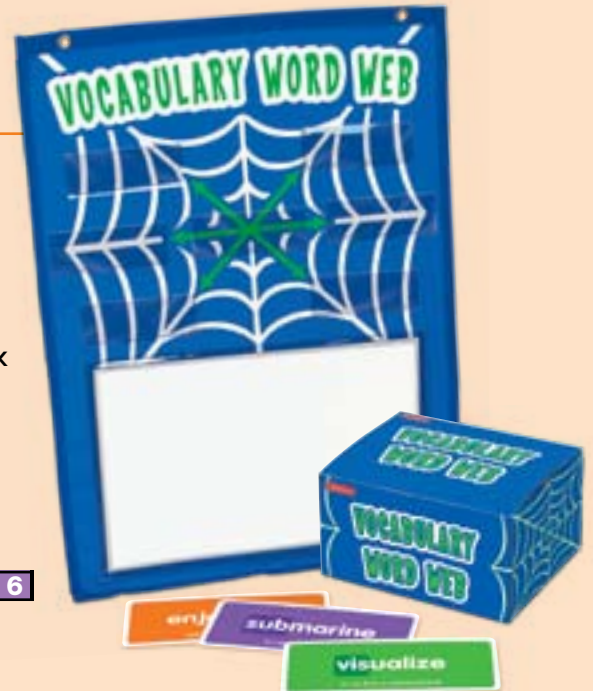
