- IEP development and promotion of practical life skills
- Progress monitoring, assessment, and accountability
- Community and family involvement




Key Elements of Core Content Access

Performance Indicators Aligned to California Standards – Provides specific performance indicators for current standards in Language, Math, Science, History/Social Science, Health, Physical Education, and Visual & Performing Arts.

IEP Development – Features detailed instructions for developing and managing effective Individual Education Plans (IEPs). Also includes an IEP checklist and descriptions of goals & objectives related to student communication, self-care, functional academics, social/emotional development, and more.

Assessment – Includes information on assessment in relation to curriculum and instruction, sample assessments—plus schedules and criteria for regular, annual, and triennial forms of assessment.





Key Elements of Instructional Best Practices

Classroom Organization – Highlights the importance of daily & weekly schedules, the development of lesson plans, the physical arrangement of the classroom, instructional needs, working with substitutes, and more.

Community-Based Instruction – Focuses on "off-campus" educational experiences that promote functional life skills. Features helpful information on the use of school & parent funds, sample request forms, and more.


Transition Planning Guide – Provides materials for promoting the transition from school to adult life—with packets for parents & students that address daily living skills, employment, and support programs.

The L.I.S.S.T. and The B.R.I.D.G.E. – Featuring 27 skill areas, the L.I.S.S.T. is a reference for IEP teams to use when developing plan goals. The B.R.I.D.G.E. includes over 180 modifiable letters to families designed to maximize their involvement in educational activities.






<u>Student Annual Needs Determination Inventory (SANDI)</u> - Set of 10 The SANDI is a comprehensive assessment tool for measuring students' current levels of performance related to functional skills and California content standards. It clearly

indicates each area of student need and aligns to corresponding standards—facilitating the writing of standards-based IEPs on an annual and triennial basis.




Each domain is divided into levels 1-6. Levels 2-5 follow CAPA levels and are developmental in nature.


Basics² organization and layout

- **Goal Area** Depending on the domain, the goal areas target everything from counting money to grooming to positive work behavior and appropriate volume of voice.
- **Goal Number** Goal numbers represent a developmental progression of skills that flow through each CAPA level.
- Generalization Outcome Practical outcomes indicate how different skills will be applied in real-world situations.
- Alignment to Standards A quick glance shows teachers how each goal aligns to the CAPA blueprints, California state standards, and more.

- Objectives That Support Assessment Clear objectives provide assessment tools for determining student progress.
- Starter Tasks for Teachers Simple starter tasks for each goal area assist teachers in addressing each objective.
