How to Make It

- Assist crafters in cutting a sheet of green construction paper in half so it measures 6" x 9". Then have crafters cut a sheet of black construction paper into thirds, creating 4" x 9" strips. Direct crafters to glue a strip of the black paper along the bottom edge of the green paper.
- 2 Assist crafters in tracing and cutting the buckle template from white construction paper. Invite crafters to color the buckle. Then direct crafters to center the buckle on the black strip and glue it in place. Have crafters use the arts and crafts supplies to decorate the hat.
- 3 Have crafters wrap the 6" x 9" green sheet into a cylinder and secure it with glue and/or tape. Assist crafters in adding two holes in the bottom edge of the cylinder—one on each side of the buckle.

Invite crafters to color a 6" paper plate green and then glue the cylinder onto the center of the plate. Assist crafters in adding two holes in the plate. Be sure the holes in the plate align with the holes in the cylinder.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- 5 Help crafters thread a yarn lace with a pony bead. Tell them to thread the yarn lace through the inside of the cylinder, out through one of the holes, and then through the hole in the paper plate. Have crafters repeat the process on the other side with a second lace and pony bead.
- Show crafters how to put on the hat by securing the laces under their chin with another pony bead. Now these hats are ready to bring some luck!
