



Mobile Backpack Storage Cart


Your sturdy new Mobile Backpack Storage Cart has hooks for 28 backpacks. Follow these instructions to assemble the unit. (The task will require that you have a friend help you.) All the tools and hardware you need are provided. Begin by checking the list below to make sure you can identify the components.

<p>side supports (2)</p>	<p>caster wrench casters (2 locking and 2 free-rolling)</p>



Assembly Instructions


- 1 Lay the wire rack on the floor, and stand one of the side supports next to it. Align the holes at the bottom of the side support with the holes at the end of the rack.




- 2 Insert the screws through each leg of the side support and into the rack. Use the Allen wrench to secure the part in place. Do not fully tighten any parts until the unit is completely assembled. Repeat with the side support at the opposite end of the cart.




- 3** Position the lower hanger bar between the midpoint of the side supports, so that the holes are aligned on the interior of the support. Secure with bolts inserted from the outside of the side supports. (Be sure to thread each bolt through a washer.)




- 4** Position the upper hanger bar between the side supports so that the holes align. Insert bolts from the outside of the side supports into the holes within the hanger bar. Use the Allen wrench to secure the part in place.



- 5** Lay the cart on its side. Screw the two locking casters into the ends of the side supports that are diagonally opposite each other. Use the wrench to tighten the nuts on the casters. Repeat with the non-locking casters.



- 6** Set the cart upright. Use the Allen wrench to tighten all of the bolts and screws on the unit. Keep the Allen wrench to periodically check and tighten the screws, as some loosening may occur over time. It is also recommended that you hang any backpacks with roller wheels on the lower hanger bar.



That's it! Your Mobile Backpack Storage Cart is ready to use. Roll it into place and push down on the tabs to lock the casters.
