


Store & Roll Organizer Cart

Your sturdy new Store & Roll Organizer Cart stores tons of classroom supplies—in one handy, portable unit. Follow these instructions to assemble the unit. (The task will be easier if you have a friend help you.) All the tools & hardware you'll need are provided. Check the list below to make sure you can identify the components.




Assembly Instructions

Insert a side rack into each side piece. The rack with the Lakeshore name-plate should be attached to the left side. Next, use four bolts to attach the bottom shelf to the sides. Make sure that both side pieces have the back rack holes facing the rear and that there are no holes facing forward. Side pieces should have 9 holes facing outside and 6 holes facing inside.




ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED—This product contains hardware that, before assembly, can pose a choking hazard to children under the age of 3 years. Care should be taken when unpackaging and assembling this product.

Use four bolts to attach the second shelf to the unit. Make sure that the metal nub is in the front of the unit. Next, attach the 3 middle shelves to the unit with 12 bolts.




Use two bolts to attach each of the two crossbars. Make sure the "T" crossbar is in front, with the metal nub lined up with the one on the second shelf. The nub should be horizontal and not pointing up or down. (See the inset below.)



Slide the divider into place, and then use 2 small bolts and 2 bolts to attach it to the unit. Make sure that the divider lines up on the right side of the nubs (when facing the cart) so that the divider is centered

when it is attached.




Gently lay the cart on its side. Use the caster wrench to attach the locking and free-rolling casters to the unit. To ensure stability, place the locking casters on diagonal corners of the cart.



6 Stand the cart back upright. Insert the back rack into the sides of the unit, and then attach it with 2 small bolts. Next, use 2 small bolts to attach each of the back rack supports to the unit. Make sure that the supports hook under the rack before attaching them.



7 Insert 2 side supports into each side of the unit. Make sure that the short, curved nubs are the ones you insert into the supports, not the longer, straight ones. Finally, place the top shelf on top of the unit so that it rests on top of the two crossbars.



8 That's it! Your Store & Roll Organizer Cart is complete and ready to use. Roll it into place and push down on the tabs to lock the casters.
