Lacing Game

Designed to meet these objectives:

- Students will build fine motor control.
- Students will develop color and shape recognition.
- Students will increase eye/hand coordination.

Students build color and shape recognition and develop finger dexterity...with an engaging lacing game they can play independently or in small groups! Children just roll the fun shape and color dice to select each jumbo bead, and then string them together to form a friendly snake!



WARNING:

Not for children under 3 yrs.

What's Included

- 4 starter beads with attached laces
- Wooden color die
- Wooden shape die
- 64 jumbo wooden beads

Using Your Lacing Game

Your Roll & Match Lacing Game includes 4 starter beads (each shaped as the head of a friendly snake with an attached string “tail” for lacing), so up to 4 students can play at once. Provide each player with a starter bead, and encourage students to take turns rolling the color die and the shape die. Then, the student hunts for the bead of the color and shape she just rolled. The activity proceeds until each player has finished stringing her snake.

For younger children, use one die at a time. Once children are comfortable using the shape and color dice independently, invite them to roll both.
