## Firefighter's Hat

Ages 3+

### What You'll Need

- Construction Paper - 9" x 12" Assorted Colors (TA50AC)
- Flexible Foam Shapes (LC2831)
- Best-Buy Washable Broad-Tip Markers - Each (JJ438) and/or Lakeshore 12-Color Large Crayons - Single Pack (VX274)
- Best-Buy Scissors - Blunt-Tip - Each (TS547)
- Craft Tape Pack - 1" Bright Colors (SD742)
- Tacky Glue - 4 Ounces (TG170)



#### MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- Firefighter's Badge Template
- Hat Template

### How to Make It

*Prep Work:* Trace the firefighter's hat and badge templates onto construction paper. Then cut them out and provide one of each to every crafter.

*NOTE:* To make it easier for crafters to use the tacky glue, try pouring small amounts into collage bowls (or paper bowls). Then provide crafters with paintbrushes to spread the glue onto their craft.

- 1 Provide each crafter with a sentence strip, and a firefighter's hat and badge.
- 2 Assist crafters with assembling the hat by laying the sentence strip flat and gluing the hat to its center.
- 3 Invite crafters to glue on the badge. Then have them decorate the sentence strip with the other arts & crafts materials.
- 4 Once the materials dry, help crafters wrap the sentence strip around their head to size the hat—and secure it closed with craft tape. Now kids are ready to keep cool in any situation!
