#### AVAILABLE IN OUR STORES:

- Construction Paper - 9" x 12" - Assorted Colors (TA50AC)
- Hair-Colors Crinkle Strips (LA716)
- Jumbo Colored Craft Sticks (HL125)
- Best-Buy Scissors - Blunt-Tip - Each (TS547)
- Tacky Glue - 4 Ounces (TG170)

#### MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- 9" paper plates
- Hat templates
- Cotton balls



### How to Make It

#### Prep Work:


- Allow the crafter to select a hat template. Then trace it onto construction paper and cut it out.
- Cut out the center of the paper plate, leaving about a three-inch rim.

*NOTE: To make it easier for crafters to use the Tacky Glue, try pouring small amounts into collage bowls (or paper bowls). Then provide crafters with paintbrushes to spread the glue onto their craft.*

- 1 Provide each crafter with a prepped paper plate, construction paper hat, and jumbo craft stick.
- 2 Direct crafters to glue the craft stick to the back of the plate and have them turn their plate over. Then have crafters glue the hat to the plate on the opposite side of the craft stick.
- 3 Invite crafters to use the crinkle strips, cotton balls, and other collage materials to bring their president to life!
- 4 Once the materials dry, invite crafters to wear their masks—and have them do their best imitation of George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, or any other president!
