April Showers Pop-Up Card

- Construction Paper - 9" x 12" - Assorted Colors (TA50AC)
- Family People Shapes™ (LC175)
- Wiggly Eyes (BJ2580)
- Flexible Foam Shapes (LC2831)
- Pipe Stems - 100 Pieces (BA7112)
- Best-Buy Washable Broad-Tip Markers (JJ438) and/or Lakeshore 12-Color Large Crayons (VX274)
- Best-Buy Scissors - Blunt-Tip (TS547)
- Craft Tape Pack - 1" Bright Colors (SD742)
- Tacky Glue (TG170)



How to Make It

Prep Work:

- Cut the construction paper into thirds horizontally so each piece measures 9" x 4".

NOTE: To make it easier for crafters to use the tacky glue, try pouring small amounts into collage bowls (or paper bowls). Then provide crafters with paintbrushes for spreading the glue onto their craft.

- 1 Assist each crafter with folding a sheet of tagboard into thirds.
- 2 Invite crafters to create a spring-inspired picture on the tagboard using the arts and crafts materials.
- 3 Provide each crafter with a precut strip of construction paper and a pipe stem for creating the umbrella.
- 4 Direct crafters to fold the paper accordion-style and then fold it in half. Assist them with taping the pipe stem into the center fold, and then taping the accordion's edges together to keep the middle closed.
- 5 Then have crafters place the umbrella into one of the card's folds, and glue or tape the umbrella's outside edges to the card.
- 6 Once the materials dry, this adorable pop-up card is sure to brighten anyone's day!
