How to Make It

- 1 Assist crafter in cutting six 1" wide x 12" long strips of tagboard. Advise crafter to take four strips and cut them in half to measure 1" wide x 6" long. Then take two strips and cut them into thirds, so they measure 1" wide by 4" long.
- 2 Direct crafter to take all the strips and hole-punch both ends of them. Advise crafter to take the long strips and thread one set of the punched holes with a brad and secure them together. Have crafter repeat with the short strips, but in addition to the brad, have crafter also thread the hole with both ends of a yarn lace, knot it and then close the brad.
- 3 Have crafter bend both sets of strips into a "C" shape. Assist crafter in taking a third brad and threading it through the remaining hole punches in the short strips and then through the remaining holes in the long strips, securing them all together. Assist crafter in spreading the strips out to round out the snowman.
- 4 Invite crafter to decorate the snowman using the available arts and crafts materials. Assist crafter in adding a cute cupcake liner hat to the snowman by hole-punching the middle of it and sliding it down over the yarn lace.
- 5 Once all the materials dry, this adorable snowman is ready to chill!
