- Paper cups

How to Make It

- 1 Assist crafters in cutting the bottom off a paper cup. Have crafters set the bottom aside. Tell crafters to turn the cup upside down and cut a small slit just above the cup's rim.
- 2 Direct crafters to cut a sheet of tagboard into quarters. Advise crafters to roll a tagboard quarter into a cylinder and secure it closed with craft tape.
- 3 Have crafters fold one end of a cylinder and tape it to the disk-shaped bottom they cut from the cup. Help crafters push the remaining end of the cylinder into the slit in the cup. Tell them to fold the end of the cylinder against the inside of the cup and tape the cylinder in place.
- 4 Instruct crafters to tape one end of a pipe stem inside the top edge of the cup and tape the other end outside the bottom edge of the cup.
- 5 Invite crafters to decorate the watering can using the available arts and crafts supplies.
- 6 Once the materials dry, crafters can practice their gardening skills using this adorable watering can!
