

Grammar Tic-Tac-Toe Game

Designed to meet these objectives:

Language

- Students will identify parts of speech.
- Students will form plurals correctly.
- Students will recognize verb tenses.
- Students will identify correct punctuation in sentences.
- Students will recognize words that should be capitalized.

Play a classic game in a new way—and add some fun to grammar practice! The pocket chart format makes the game easy to set up and allows you to change or rearrange questions each time children play. Self-checking question cards are ideal for independent use in your learning center. There's even a storage pocket in the back of the chart to keep extra question cards handy!

What's Included

- Nylon pocket chart
- 36 question cards with answers on back
- 14 "X" and "O" cover cards

How to Play

Invite two children (or two teams) to play against each other. Place 9 question cards in the pockets with the questions facing out and give each player a set of 7 "X" or "O" cover cards. Players take turns choosing a square and reading the question. The player then says the answer aloud and checks her answer on the back of the card. If she answered correctly, she may place her cover card in front of the question card in the pocket. If not, she leaves the question card in place. The first player to get three cover cards in a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal row wins the game!
