- the word "I"



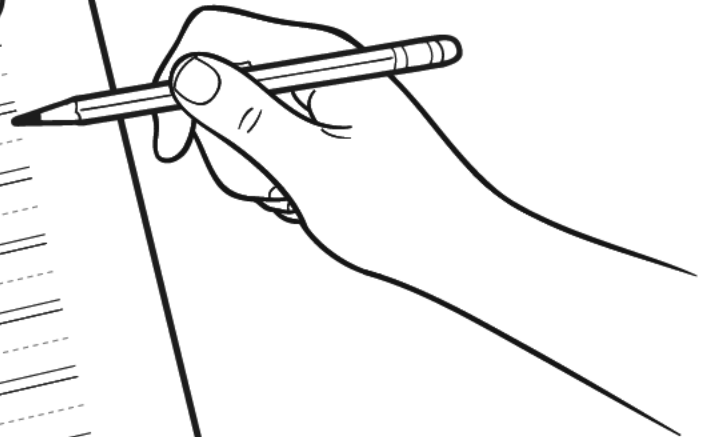

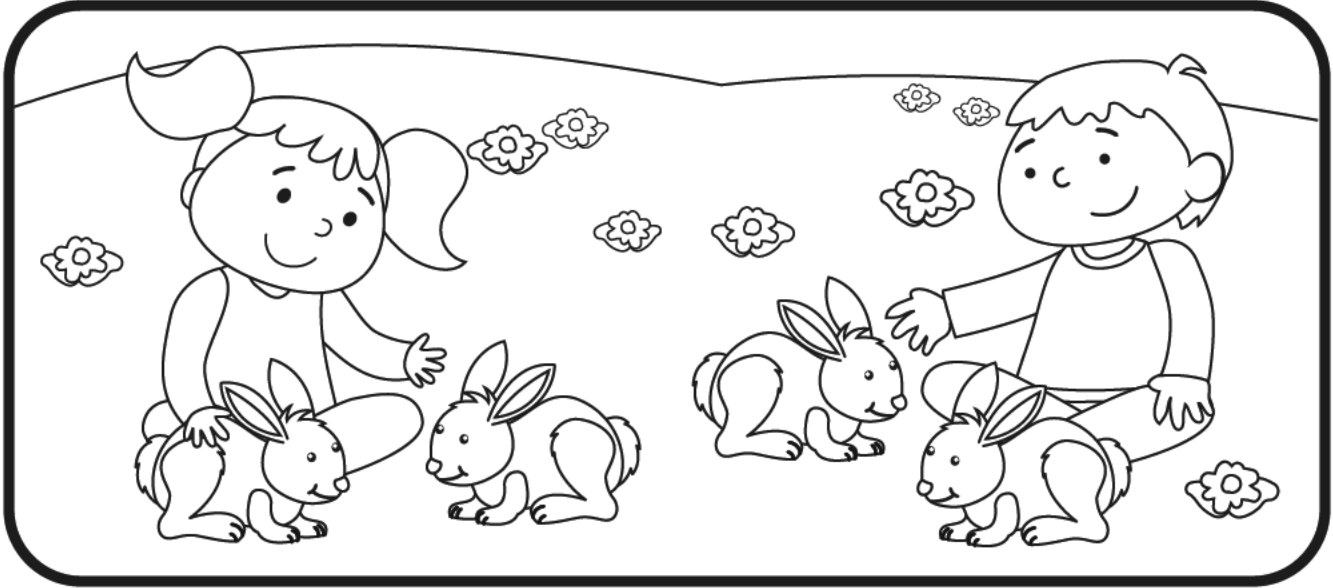
