

Alphabet Ants!


Beginning Sounds

Instructions:

Cut along the dotted lines of the mat pages and tape the mat together. Help your child cut out the letter tiles along the dotted lines and lay them faceup on a flat surface. Point to an ant on the mat and name the object it is shown with—for example, the banana. Say the word together, emphasizing the beginning sound. Then tell your child to find the letter that makes the beginning sound and place it under the ant. Keep playing until your child has placed all 26 letters!


