Stars & Stripes Windsock



What You'll Need

AVAILABLE IN OUR STORES:

- White Tagboard - 9" x 12" (TD271)
- Construction Paper - 9" x 12" - Blue (TA50BU)
- Construction Paper - 9" x 12" - Red (TA50RD)
- Craft Tape Pack - 1/2" (SD748)
- Flexible Foam Shapes (LC2831)
- Yarn Laces with Tips (FG639)
- Best-Buy Scissors - Blunt-Tip (TS547)
- Hole-Punch (SPG156)
- Tacky Glue - 4 Ounces (TG170)

How to Make It

- 1 Have crafters cut a sheet of blue construction paper into thirds so the strips measure 3" wide. Then instruct crafters to cut each strip in half so the pieces measure 3" wide x 6" long. Have crafters glue one of the blue pieces along the top edge of a sheet of white tagboard.
- 2 Help crafters cut 1" strips into a sheet of red and/or blue construction paper. Instruct crafters to glue and/or tape the sheets to the back of the white tagboard.
- 3 Direct crafters to add craft-tape stripes to the white area and foam stars to the blue area.
- 4 Have crafters wrap the tagboard into a cylinder and secure it closed with craft tape. Help them punch three holes along the top of the cylinder and knot a yarn lace through each hole.
- 5 Ask crafters to pull together and knot the loose yarn-lace ends. This windsock is ready to be displayed in honor of Memorial Day!
