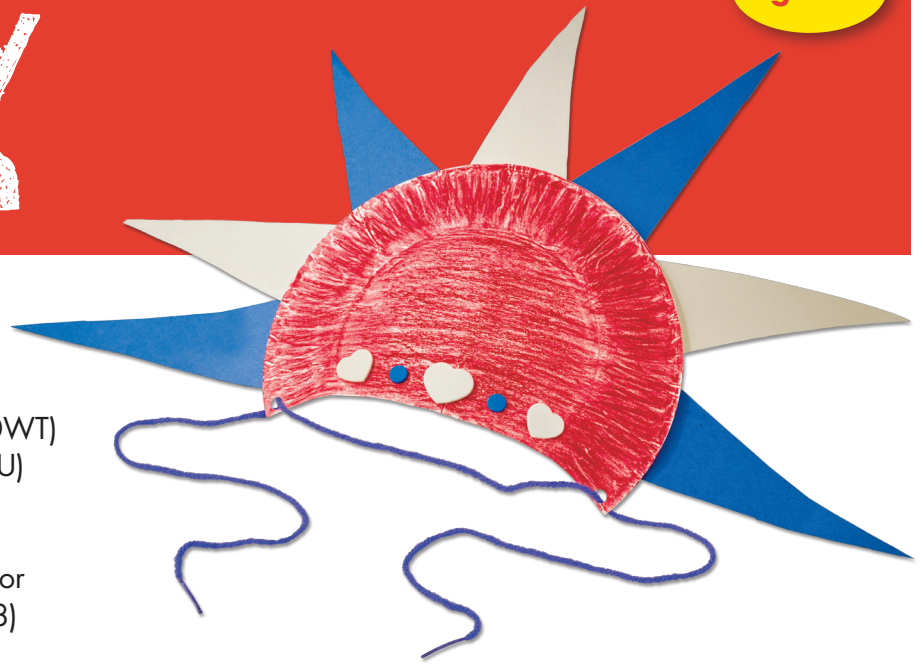
Liberty Crown

- Construction Paper - 9" x 12" - White (TA50WT)
- Construction Paper - 9" x 12" - Blue (TA50BU)
- Yarn Laces with Tips (FG639)
- Flexible Foam Shapes (LC2831)
- Lakeshore 12-Color Large Crayons (VX274) or Best-Buy Washable Broad-Tip Markers (JJ438)
- Best-Buy Scissors - Blunt-Tip (TS547)
- Craft Tape Pack - 1" Bright Colors (SD742)
- Hole-Punch (SPG156)
- Tacky Glue - 4 Ounces (TG170)



MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- 9" paper plates
- Triangle template

How to Make It

- 1 Invite crafters to use the template to trace seven triangles onto white and blue construction paper and cut them out.
- 2 Help crafters cut an arch into one end of a paper plate. Set the plate facedown.
- 3 Have crafters decorate the plate using collage materials.
- 4 Direct crafters to turn the plate over and glue and/or tape the triangles along the rounded edge.
- 5 Instruct crafters to punch one hole at each corner of the crown and thread the holes with a yarn lace.
- 6 When the crowns are dry, help crafters secure them in place to show their patriotic pride!
